THE INFORMATION BELOW IS CONFIDENTIAL - FOR USE BY AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL ONLY

ON THE LISTED DATE AND APPROXIMATE TIME, D. READER OBSERVED VESSEL ASHLEY CHANEL PUSHING A LARGE CRANE OUTBOUND TOWARD THE CHESAPEAKE BAY, PASS IN FRONT OF THE CITY MARINA. APPROXIMATELY 20 MINUTES AFTER OBSERVATION, D. READER HEARD OVER VHF RADIO CHANNEL #16, REPORTS OF LARGE DEBRIS FLOATING IN THE CHANNEL, CREATING A NAVIGATION HAZARD.

AT THAT TIME, D. READER NOTIFIED MPO G.E. YATES OF THE NAVIGATION HAZARD VIA CELL PHONE. D. READER ALSO DEBRIEFED MPO YATES OF VESSEL ASHLEY CHANEL PASSING THROUGH THE AREA AND THE NAVIGATION DIFFICULTIES. WE RESPONDED TO THE LESNER BRIDGE AND OBSERVED THE DAMAGE. THE CREW OF VESSEL KRISTINA MARIE WITNESSED THE VESSEL ASHLEY CHANEL STRIKE THE LESNER BRIDGE NORTH SPAN/WEST SIDE FENDER SYSTEM. WE OBSERVED THE ASHLEY CHANEL WEST OF THE FIRST ISLAND OF THE CHESAPEAKE BAY BRIDGE TUNNEL AND MADE CONTACT WITH THE CAPTAIN.

WE PULLED ALONG SIDE OF THE VESSEL AND OBTAINED THE CAPTAIN'S CELL PHONE NUMBER. THE CAPTAIN, NATHAN MARC SCBURA, INFORMED ME HE HAD NOTIFIED HIS SUPERVISOR WHO WAS GOING TO NOTIFY THE COAST GUARD. I NOTIFIED THE COAST GUARD OF THE CRASH AND SPOKE WITH LT. BILL CLARK (757-668-5581) AND BM2 KENT SHRONTZ, [REDACTED] FROM LITTLE CREEK WAS DISPATCHED TO HE LESNER BRIDGE TO INVESTIGATE.

D. READER GAVE ALL THE CAPTAIN'S INFORMATION TO THE CREW FOR THE INVESTIGATION. OFFICER KAATZ, [REDACTED] RESPONDED TO THE CITY MARINA AND PHOTOGRAPHED THE DAMAGE. AT 0420 HOURS. CONSTRUCTION INSPECTOR SUPERVISOR OF VIRGINIA BEACH WAS NOTIFIED AND RESPONDED TO THE CITY MARINA AND PHOTOGRAPHED AND INSPECTED THE DAMAGE, AT 1015 HOURS, ROBERT A. BIDLACK (757- [REDACTED]).
